SEN Reviews

All pupils who have an SEN Pupil Profile will be contacted by the class teacher or the school office to arrange the final review of the academic year before the end of term. This document is written to support your child with their learning in school as well as suggestions of activities which can be completed at home. We review SEN Pupil Profiles three times a year and the Pupil Profile update in June/July will be shared with your child's class teacher next year.

Parents will be informed of their child's class teacher for next year on Friday 5th July. Support is already being provided to children for transition to their next year group for all children from Nursery to Y6. This includes opportunities to visit the different areas of the school, meet the adults who work in those areas, discuss the different structure of the school day and even play on the new playground. Please ensure over the coming weeks that you speak positively to your child about the transition to a new year group, whether this be within grookside or to secondary school. A phrase which is often used for parents is that they are 'the anchor in a changing world' and it is important that parents feel calm and happy about any

Meetings with teachers

It is important that pupils and teachers have a smooth start to the school day and for this to occur both pupils and teachers need to be in the classroom at the beginning of the school day. If you have a message for the class teacher which they need to know that morning please call and leave a voicemail or email the school office. If you would like the opportunity to talk for longer to your child's teacher then please speak to them at the end of the day or speak to Mrs Ashcroft who can arrange a convenient time.


